



12 Hour Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) Trainings

*Open to all regional partners in Jefferson, Lewis and St. Lawrence Counties.

This free 12-hour training will provide you with the knowledge and ability to implement Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT).

SBIRT is a comprehensive, integrated, public health approach to the delivery of early intervention and treatment services for persons with substance use disorders, as well as those who are at risk of developing these disorders.


This training focuses on screening procedures to identify risk; key motivational interviewing concepts and brief intervention; and referral to treatment for patients with more serious alcohol use-related problems.

- **Screening** quickly assesses the severity of substance use and identifies the appropriate level of treatment.
- **Brief intervention** focuses on increasing insight and awareness regarding substance use and motivation toward behavioral change.
- **Referral to treatment** provides those identified as needing more extensive treatment with access to specialty care.

Reimbursement for screening and brief intervention is available through commercial insurance, Medicare, and Medicaid.

Where Can SBIRT Be Implemented? **Any setting where there is potential for an intervention.**

Primary care centers, hospital emergency rooms, trauma centers, and other community settings provide opportunities for early intervention with at-risk substance users before more severe consequences occur.
