



DSRIP Site Definition

Background: The “Phase 2 Funds Flow Distribution and Payment Schedule” refers to participants in each project being identified at the site level, which is then tied to its entity. The DSRIP site definition described below determines which of the entity’s sites, in addition to the overall entity, are included in the funds flow determination by project.

Additional DSRIP Site Determination

DSRIP Involvement: A site should independently have an impact to the overall goal of DSRIP, to reduce avoidable hospitalizations for the Medicaid population.

Additional Site Requirements: A site will hold a separate operating certificate or reside in a separate location. Additional sites must participate in a DSRIP project in addition to project 2.a.i. and accept Medicaid if the site is a billing entity.

Exceptions:

- School-based clinics with multiple sites will collectively be considered one site
- Housing providers with multiple sites will collectively be considered one site

Site Participation in a Project

To be considered a part of a project, a site will have all of the following:

- Project specific implementation plan
- At least 16 hours of on-site work each week
